PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS
JULY 11, 2023

The Public Works Committee meeting was called to order by Chairman Bruce Goetsch at the Weyauwega Municipal Building Council Chambers at 8:01 pm immediately following the Police, Fire & Ambulance Committee Meeting. Roll call was taken. Members Present: Bruce Goetsch, and Chris Gunderson. Not Present: Kaley DuCoeur. Also Present: Mayor Rick Luedke, City Administrator Jeremy Schroeder, City Clerk Rebecca Loehrke, Police Chief Brandon Leschke, Dewey Stelzner, Shani Appleby and Tim Litscher.

Department Update: Schroeder reported on the following items:

- Following the Forest Management Plan staff has planted some new trees in the park and one that needed to be replaced on Main Street.
- Freightliner is leaking oil worse than before. Someone will be coming out to look to see if it can be driven to the shop to work on or trailed there.
- Husqvarna mower is still down. Waiting on parts to come in to fix.
- Lots of activity at the park with shelter rentals and people visiting the swim lake.
- Summer help is doing a good job on keeping the park clean
- The new door in the Community Room is being worked on but not finished yet.
- Center line paint stripping was done yesterday.
- Now that we are out of the garage for Agropur we have found out that there is no 220 power to run a welder and air compressor. Will be having 220 power installed into the garage behind City Hall.
- Electrical work and the gas hook up needs to take place yet for the East Street generator.

County AA and Lakeview Lane Intersection Quote: Have not received a quote yet from the County. The intersection is in bad condition due to the heavy truck traffic. There is not enough layers of asphalt in the intersection. The County is already scheduled to do work in the area so would not have additional mobilization fees. Waiting to see what the cost would be to make it proper for truck traffic.

Garage turnover to Agropur Update: The City was completely out of the garage on June 30th and turned over to Agropur. Water and electric has been changed to their name. A new gas meter will need to be installed to separate it from the rest of the service to the treatment plant area. A security fence is being installed on Wednesday.

Welcome to Weyauwega Signs Maintenance: The two Welcome to Weyauwega signs along Highway 10 need some maintenance to the track system for lettering. TLC originally did the sign and have been contacted to look into the plastic track system which should be minimal to repair. The sign on the Stearns property did get some hail damage to it.

Set next meeting date/time: The next committee meeting will be held on August 8th immediately following the Police, Fire and Ambulance Committee meeting.
