<u>Department Update:</u> Chief Poltrock reported that there have been 897 calls for service thus far for 2020.

<u>Gold Cross Annual Meeting at Weyauwega City Hall:</u> Administrator Schroeder informed the committee that Executive Director of Gold Cross, Mark Fredrickson requested the meeting for July 30<sup>th</sup> beginning at 6 pm here at City Hall. This is for all municipalities/townships in Waupaca County that they cover to discuss the 2020 Budget and projections for 2021.

**Staffing Update:** Part-time officer Alex Midthun cannot work for the foreseeable future due to his full-time job at the jail. Chief further reported that Officer Walby was injured on a call and cannot work until cleared. Preliminary diagnosis might be an ACL injury. This only leaves part-time Officer Tesch to fill in. The Chief has posted for part-time officers but have only received 3 applicants so far. Training a new person can take up to 6 weeks. Stelzner asked worst case scenario could the county cover? Chief said that the county Sheriff's office has COVID cases along with jail staff so they are tightening up. Chief, Sergeant and Administrator are going to meet this week to do some planning.
