**Discussion on Chapter 95-11 Salaries:** Council President Gunderson asked for discussion on the chapter on payment of salaries for Mayor and Council. She does not believe it is correct from what was discussed last year. It is missing how Mayor and Council would get paid for additional meetings outside of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the Month Committee Meetings. Currently the ordinance states \$80 per diem per day which was for the multiple meeting nights (2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month) where in the past the council received \$25 per meeting. Gunderson believes in past conversations any additional meetings outside of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month should still be paid at \$25 per meeting not \$80. Corrections should be made to the ordinance and brought back to committee for review next month. *Motion Berg, second Appleby, to correct 95-11(B)(3) to add any additional meeting attended by council or mayor outside of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month committee meetings is to receive an additional \$25 per meeting. Motion carried with all "ayes".*
