<u>Gold Cross Ambulance Update Presentation:</u> Mark Fredrickson with Gold Cross gave an update on how 2021 is going for the ambulance service. Last year's slowdown due to COVID started in February. Normal months there would be over 100 ambulance calls and last year they averaged 35 calls some months. 1st quarter of 2021 they are seeing a change and an increase in calls which he believes shows us coming out of COVID. Transports continue to be down which means less people are still not going to the hospital. He is working on educating his staff to inform patients that hospitals are a safe place to go to. If the numbers hold where they are, our subsidy money could be going down.

Department Update: Leschke reported that there were 138 calls of service for the month of April. School Resource Officer DeGrand and Officer Keberlein will be attending training in Wisconsin Dells on profiling. The Chief will be hosting the legal update at City Hall on May 20th. It is open to the whole county and will be held in two sessions.

Administrator Report: Nothing further to report.
