PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS
JUNE 7, 2022

The Public Works Committee meeting was called to order by Chairman Bruce Goetsch at the Weyauwega Municipal Building Council Chambers at 7:16 pm. Roll call was taken. Members Present: Bruce Goetsch, and Chris Gunderson. Not Present: Cameron Looker. Also Present: City Administrator Jeremy Schroeder, and Clerk Rebecca Loehrke.

Motion Goetsch, second Gunderson, to approve the minutes from May 10, 2022. Motion carried with all "ayes".

Engineer Report: Schroeder reported that the closing on the Clean Water Fund Loan will take place tomorrow morning, June 8th.

Manor Drive Lighting Update: With the delay in the project due to Waupaca County cleaning up their electrical issues, WE Energies also decided to clean up their equipment in that area. The original quote from WE Energies to install three lights along Manor Drive was \$6,144. Now it is only going to cost the City \$350 with two lights being installed on Manor Drive before the railroad tracks.

Administrator Report: Schroeder reported on the following items from the department:

- The lift station pump at World Class will be installed this week or early next week. Then will work on the Industrial Park East lift station pump.
- Staff has been busy working with issues on the lime auger at the WWTP, mowing and cleaning at the park, getting chlorinator repaired at the pool.
- Kaitlyn Appleby, the summer employee, started on Monday
- Dillion Tongusi is the new hire in Public Works and will start on June 27th
- Two street areas that were damaged from the water main break were asphalted.
- Some reconstructive work was done on Clark Street to help with water runoff

Such Other Matters as Authorized by Law: Gunderson would like to discuss at the next committee meeting the truck traffic on Lake Street and Wisconsin Street. Will also list on the Police Agenda for discussion.
