Police Department Update: Chief Leschke had a written report in the meeting packet. A few items he touched on were:

- Officer DeGrand had her 5 year full-time status anniversary
- Received the AED from UWO Nursing Students and Gold Cross. Waiting to have it installed in the vestibule of City Hall. Has a sign to display indicating a AED is available. Will need to determine if the sign should be outside City Hall or inside the vestibule.
- ▶ Flock Camera is hopefully getting installed on December 13th. Was cancelled for the 12th.
- A K-9 Sniff was performed at the Weyauwega & Fremont Schools. Nothing illegal was found.
- Don Morgan expressed his gratitude to Officer Bachaus for her professional service and assistance during a medical emergency. She is a wonderful ambassador to the City.
- Interviewed a part-time candidate who will be graduating from FVTC on Friday. The candidate will be working for both Iola PD and Weyauwega PD.
- The 2023 Dodge Charger is back and in service. New tires have been ordered for the 2018 and 2021 Tahoe. The 2018 Tahoe had the windshield replaced because of a chip that turned into a crack.
- 320 Calls for service in November included 55 traffic citations, 48 traffic warnings, 1 municipal ordinance citation and 2 motor vehicle accident reports.
- SRO DeGrand attended training for Child Passenger Safety Technician and is now certified to inspection car seats. SRO DeGrand, Police Department and School Staff are all trained in Stop the Bleed program. Working to include in health classes at School.
