March Calls for Service Report and Department Update: Chief Leschke went over his report that was included in the meeting packet. 279 calls for service in March which included 50 traffic citations being issued, 13 written traffic warnings issued, and 6 municipal ordinance citations issued. Chief Leschke went over meetings and events attended by the department. Erik Grenlie has accepted a conditional offer of employment as a part-time officer. He is going through the appropriate testing for the hiring process. Leschke also received another application for part-time employment and will be scheduling an initial interview. Citations have gone out to a few properties that refuse to communicate in regards to their ordinance violations. A dog kennel has been installed in the PD garage at a cost of \$250. It will fold flat when not in use. The Flock camera is up in its temporary location on Mill Street. Gunderson asked about the 90-minute parking signs on Main Street. They are very faded and difficult to read. The signs can either be removed or replaced. The Chief is not sure how the ordinance on parking is written. The 90 minutes is not something the department enforces. Will check the ordinance first and if no mention on 90 minutes on Main Street they will then be removed.
