Discussion and possible action on Main Street Farmer's Market: Schroeder brought the idea of a Farmer's Market forward after having discussions with several business owners. He would like to close down the 100 block of E. Main Street for the Farmer's Market which would also allow people to visit local businesses in the area. Would like to hold it on a week night so to not interfere with the markets held on the weekends around the area. Committee was very receptive to the idea. Think it is better to have on Main Street then the back parking lot for better visibility of traffic going thru town. Looking at doing it on Thursday evenings starting in late summer from either 2–6 pm or 3–7 pm. Schroeder will check with businesses on Main Street to make sure it would not interfere with anything they would have going on. He spoke with the State Farmer's Market Association and they will help to advertise it. Schroeder will continue to work on planning for a Farmer's Market to start in September.
