## Engineering Update:

a. Set Date/Time for Public Information Meeting on Lead Service Program: The meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 21, 2025 at 6 pm in the Community Room of City Hall. This will give time for staff to get letters out to residents. May look at putting a notice in the paper.

**Department Update:** Leschke reported that the E. Main Street sidewalk is completed. There was a change order with the inground electrical box, so cost came in at \$6,300 versus \$5,500. Overall, the department is doing well. Scheduling for next year is done with the on-call schedule. Leschke is encouraging staff to take some training. There was a valve blow out in a basement room at the WWTP. Staff cleaned up the room, but he was told that it can use more cleaning. Will be having staff work on it. The new payloader should be delivered on Wednesday. Will then advertise the current plow for sale versus putting it on an online auction. Staff have been brining streets and will do more on Friday. The freightliner sold for \$3,500.
