PROCEEDINGS OF THE SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL CITY OF WEYAUWEGA TUESDAY, JUNE 1, 2021

The Special Common Council meeting of the City of Weyauwega was called to order at 6:33 p.m., on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 by Mayor Jack Spierings in the Weyauwega Municipal Building Council Chambers.

Roll Call: Present: Mayor Jack Spierings, Rich Luedke, Chris Gunderson, Bruce Goetsch, Shani Appleby, and Cameron Looker. Not present: Kaley DuCoeur. Also present: City Administrator Jeremy Schroeder, Clerk Rebecca Loehrke, City Engineer Andy Schmidt from McMahon, Frank Zaboj, Chris Johnson and Randy Faulks with Faulks Brothers Construction, and Aaron Green with Northeast Asphalt. The meeting began with the saying of the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor Jack Spierings.

Recommend to approve the bid for the Canoe/Kayak Launch Trail and Parking Lot Upgrades: Goetsch felt for a difference in bids that it should be awarded to Faulks Bros for the history of what they have done for the City. He feels this is the best option. The bids come from two well know companies and are very competitive with only being \$2,100 difference. Green with Northeast Asphalt noted that if it is not awarded to the lowest bidder than what incentive is there for other companies to come back and do work in the City. Looker said the Recreation Committee had to put personal feelings aside and it came down to the recommendation to award to the lowest bidder. They are both excellent companies and it is just business. Johnson spoke and agreed with Green that competition is good and all the bids were honest and true bids. Motion Luedke, second Appleby, to approve the recommendation of the Recreation Committee and award both bids to Northeast Asphalt for a total of \$88,151.30. Motion carried with four "ayes" and one "nay" from Goetsch.

Consider Temporary Class "B" Retailer's License to the Taco House for June 19, 2021: Motion Luedke, second Gunderson, to approve a temporary class "B" retailer's license to the Taco House for June 19, 2021 at the Waupaca County Fairgrounds. Motion carried with five "ayes", zero "nays".
