PUBLIC HEALTH AND RELIEF (ORDINANCE) COMMITTEE MEETING PROCEEDINGS
JULY 8, 2024

The Public Health and Relief (Ordinance) Committee meeting was called to order by Chairman Meta Berg at 6:33 pm immediately following the adjournment of the Recreation Committee meeting. Motion Berg, second Appleby, to approve the minutes from June 11, 2024. Motion carried with all "ayes".

Discussion and possible action on Ordinance 2024-3 establishing Food Truck Ordinance: Have not gotten the ordinance back from Attorney Kalny yet. Gunderson would like to make sure it is listed when a truck is in the B-1 General Business District that they know they cannot use a feathered flag sign as those types of signs are not allowed in the B-1 General Business District.

Discussion and possible action on review of UTV/ATV Ordinance: Appleby brought up that there were some things that the committee wanted to change on the ordinance. One of which is the driver needs to have a legal license. Chief Leschke would like time to review it again. Will table to the next meeting.

Discussion and possible action on review of Cemetery Ordinance 370-33 and 190-12 and rules: Appleby reported on how the signs for the cemetery contradict what is in the city ordinance. The cemetery sign says dogs on a leash are allowed and the city ordinance states animals are prohibited in cemeteries. Committee feels that we will leave it for now because once the cemetery is officially the City's the council would like to review all rules and procedures.

Set next meeting date and time: Due to the August Primary Election, the next committee meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 14, 2024 immediately following the Recreation Committee Meeting.

Such Other Matters as Authorized by Law: Gunderson asked to have the new business at 142 E Main Street know about feathered signs not allowed in the B-1 General Business District. Clerk Loehrke had already sent an email out to the business owner.
